

Brentford Community Boat House – Safeguarding Policy

The [British Rowing Safeguarding and Protecting Children Policy](#) and the [British Rowing Adults at Risk Policy](#) will be followed except where indicated below.

The Directors will appoint a person to lead on Safeguarding matters; the “Safeguarding Lead”. The contact details for the Safeguarding Lead will be made available to all users and user organisations.

Each user organisation shall have its own Safeguarding Policy which shall cover both its own members and other users of the Brentford Community Boat House site.

User organisations shall share their Safeguarding Policies with the Safeguarding Lead.

Each user organisation shall have its own lead for Safeguarding who shall be available to consult with the Safeguarding Lead when necessary.

Contact for the user organisation safeguarding leads shall be shared with the Safeguarding Lead and shall be kept up to date.

Any safeguarding issues or complaints that are in any way relate to the use of Brentford Community Boat House shall be reported to the Safeguarding Lead.

User organisations shall be responsible for ensuring that there is adequate First Aid provision for their members when using Brentford Community Boat House.

All users shall adhere to the Brentford Community Boat House Code of Conduct.

Training:

Read British Rowing Safeguarding and Protecting Children Policy: Safeguarding Lead and all Trustees, employees or volunteers of Brentford Community Boat House

Read British Rowing Adults at Risk Policy: Safeguarding Lead and all Trustees, employees or volunteers of Brentford Community Boat House

Attend British Rowing Safeguarding and Protecting Children Workshop or equivalent: Safeguarding Lead and Trustees, employees or volunteers who have significant regular contact with children using Brentford Community Boat House

Basic awareness courses for safeguarding issues (run by local authorities): Safeguarding Lead and Trustees, employees or volunteers who have significant regular contact with children or vulnerable adults using Brentford Community Boat House.

Attend CPSU “Time to Listen” CWO Course or equivalent: Safeguarding Lead
